- Start on 11 Jan 2024 (Thurs), 4pm
- End on 16 Jan 2024 (Tue), 4pm

When is the posting result released?

- 1 Feb 2024 (Thurs) via
 - a. SMS, if you have provided a local mobile number in your application
 - b. JAE-IS, which is accessible through the JAE website (using Singpass/ JAE pin)



4E5N**Acceptance of Offer to JC/ MI**

- Applicants posted to JCs/ MI are to report to their posted institutions on **2 Feb 2024, Fri**
- Your place will be forfeited if you fail to report to the JC/MI
- If you are unable to report on the first day of school, please contact your posted school directly
- You may wear your secondary school uniform and bring along identification documents (NRIC/ student's pass) when you report
- Students who had accepted offers through DSA will not be eligible to participate in the JAE.



4E5N Acceptance of Offer to Polytechnic

- Applicants posted to polytechnics will receive an **enrolment email/ enrolment package** to your residential address by **end February**
- Please **complete the online enrolment** by the date stated in the package (if not your place will be forfeited)
- If you are waiting for an appeal outcome, you should **still accept the posted course offer online**. If your appeal is successful, inform the polytechnic subsequently.



4E5N Polytechnic Early Admission Exercise (EAE)

- Students who had **accepted conditional offers** to a polytechnic course through the **EAE in 2023** and have their **offers confirmed, will not be eligible to participate in the JAE**. Their EAE offers are confirmed if they meet the following criteria:
 - a. A net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or better for the GCE O-Level examinations; and
 - b. Minimum Entry Requirements for the respective polytechnic course.
- Students who **do not meet the above criteria** will get **another chance** to apply to polytechnic via the **JAE**



4E5N Acceptance of Offer to ITE

- Applicants posted to ITE will receive an **enrolment email** on the day of release
- Please **complete the online enrolment** by the date stated in the package (if not your place will be forfeited)
- If you are waiting for an appeal outcome, you should **still accept the posted course offer online**. If your appeal is successful, inform the ITE subsequently.

- Students are required to indicate if you wish to accept, reject or appeal for a change of course by **4pm on Friday, 26 Jan 2024**
- Last day of Sec 5 for PFP-bound students: **Friday, 26 Jan 2024**
